

The National Interstate Council of State Boards of Cosmetology (the "NIC") currently develops the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology's (the "Board") examination for licensure. Through this regular rulemaking, the Board proposes to amend section 961 in Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to transfer responsibility to approve educational materials, including text and reference books, from the Board to the NIC. Additionally, the Board proposes to add the use of on-line training programs-in lieu of text books-as an acceptable form of teaching materials.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 10/1/2015.
