We are looking for committee participants that are in a position to provide more variety and a broader knowledge base for the Board, thereby greatly enhancing our knowledge and understanding of health and safety issues, workers' rights and domestic/sexual violence abuse issues facing the Barbering and Beauty industry.

The Board anticipates a one-year appointment term for Committee members. Committee membership is not considered employment with the State of California. Members serve on a voluntary basis and do not receive salary, benefits or travel reimbursement.
