

Tier 1 (Widespread) Counties

Below is a chart which summarizes which sectors are currently allowed to operate in Tier 1 counties under the Blueprint for a Safer Economy.

Sectors	Widespread Tier 1
Hair Salons/Barbershops	Open Indoors with modifications
Esthetics (skin care)	Outdoor Only with modifications
Nail Salons	Open Indoors with modifications
Electrology	Closed , except for physician-ordered electrolysis

Please note that you must also check your **county's website** to verify if there are additional restrictions or requirements. For example, your county may limit the maximum capacity indoors or prohibit services which require the client to remove their face mask. Reminder: You must adhere to the CDPH's guidelines AND any additional guidelines provided by your county. If your county's guidelines differ from CDPH's, you must comply with whichever is stricter.

Help your county move to the next tier by doing the following:

- Wear a mask in public.
- Wash your hands regularly.
- Keep at least six feet of physical distance when in public.
- Limit mixing with people you don't live with.

Tier 2 (Substantial), Tier 3 (Moderate), and Tier 4 (Minimal) Counties

Hair salons/barbershops, estheticians, nail salons, and electrologists are allowed to **open indoors with modifications** if their county is in Tier 2, 3, or 4 of the Blueprint for a Safer Economy.

However, you must also check your **county's website** to verify if there are additional restrictions or requirements. For example, your county may limit the maximum capacity indoors or prohibit services which require the client to remove their face mask.
